ORDER SETTING HEARING AND BRIEFING SCHEDULE


The Receiver has filed a report regarding objections to his Revised Claims Report. ECF No. 82. The Receiver was able to resolve a substantial number of the objections he received but seven objections remain outstanding. *Id.* Six objections are from investors and one objection is from a creditor. *Id.* Before providing interim partial distributions to investors and creditors, these objections must be resolved. The Receiver requests a hearing to resolve objections, approve claims, and authorize interim partial distributions. ECF No. 94.

The Court **GRANTS** the Receiver’s “Request for Hearing” (ECF No. 94) and **SETS a HEARING** to consider the objections to the Receiver’s Revised Claims Report. The hearing will take place on **December 8, 2022 at 11:00 a.m.** in Courtroom Number 322, on the Third Floor of the United States Courthouse, 525 Magoffin Avenue, El Paso, Texas.

Any investor or creditor who has previously filed an objection with the Receiver is permitted to file a brief in support of their objection(s). If an investor or creditor opts to file a brief, such a brief must be filed by **October 31, 2022**. If an investor or creditor files a brief in support of their objection, the Receiver shall file a response by **November 14, 2022**. The Court

ORDERS the Receiver to deliver a copy of this Order to the investors and creditors who filed claims with the Receiver.
